## Variations on a theme

**Hemerocallis 'Baja':** Color - red with light green throat (re-blooms); Height - 26 inches; Bloom time - June & July.

**'Hearts Affire':** Color - medium red; Height - 36 inches; Bloom time - July.

**'Red Magic':** Color - medium red with yellow throat; Height - 36 inches; Bloom time - June & July.

**'Happy Returns':** Color - canary yellow flowers (consistent re-bloomer); Height - 16 inches; Bloom time - May to November.

**'Hyperion':** Color - lemon yellow, delightful fragrance (re-blooms); Height - 40 inches; Bloom time - July.

**'Mary Todd':** Color - large, clear yellow ruffled flowers; Height - 26 inches; Bloom time - June.

**'Stella de Oro':** Color - golden yellow (re-blooms); Height - 12 inches; Bloom time - June to October.

**'Little Grapette':** Color - light grape-purple; Height - 12 inches; Bloom time - June.

**'Bama Music':** Color - pale pink with yellow throat; Height - 28 inches; Bloom time - July.

**'Frosty Beauty':** Color - peach, rose, orchid blend (re-blooms); Height - 32 inches; Bloom time - July.

**'Hall's Pink':** Color - light pink (low-growing); Height - 20 inches; Bloom time - August.

**'Ice Carnival':** Color - near white with green throat (re-blooms); Height - 28 inches; Bloom time - July.

**Hemerocallis fulva:** Color - orange; Height - 36 inches; Bloom time - July.

**'September Gold':** Color - deep gold; Height - 34 inches; Bloom time - August.

### FACTOIDS

- Pure white daylilies have eluded hybridizers although many pale-yellow or pink selections have come very close.
- Many versions are very fragrant.
- Favorites for many because of their low-maintenance nature.
- Good in borders, massed for accent or in natural plantings.

## Hemerocallis: Queen for a day

The persistence and durability of this genus has made it a favorite for growing in tough spots.

Tawny daylilies have even been called "ditch lilies" because they are so often seen naturalized along the roadsides.

Today daylilies are one of the most popular and varied perennials. Their flowers have three broad

petals and three narrow, petal-like sepals.

Although each flower lasts only one day, the profusion of buds keep plants blooming for two to four weeks.

Some cultivars are re-bloomers that reproduce new stalks throughout the season.

Hybrids have all colors except blue and white.
